



125th Anniversary Parade

Participation Rules



- Entries must display the parade theme of celebrating the 125 year history of Rocklin and be family friendly.
- Parade will begin at 9:00 am. All entrants need to be checked in and in line by 8:30.
- Staging will be in the Springview Middle School parking lot.
- Staging instructions will follow in separate email
- No smoking around parade staging or parade area.
- No fires, open flames, gasoline or discharging of firearms permitted
- All floats pulled by a motorized vehicle to have a fire extinguisher
- Exhaust systems will be working and extend past decorations so that drivers and riders are not exposed to carbon monoxide
- Lawn tractors must have blades removed
- All dogs must be on leash, horses bridled and both under the control of an experienced handler.
- All drivers of motor vehicles must be 21 with a valid driver license
- Parade participants under 18 must have adult supervision
- No alcohol permitted in or around the parade or staging area
- Throwing candy from a parade entry is not permitted
- Candy may be handed to spectators by a participant on foot walking at curbside- so spectators do not dart out in the street
- Political candidate or position entries are not allowed
- Entries that advocate, oppose or depict any social issue, or any entry which the Parade Committee deem to offend public decency will not be allowed.
- Inspection will take place during parade lineup and any entries failing to comply with the above rules will not be allowed to participate.

Each participant in an entry must have a signed liability waiver
